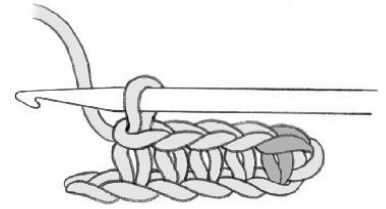

Knitting Tip: Using a life-line

This is a preventative measure when doing lace work, or any knitting where unraveling and putting stitches back on the needles properly would be tricky or impossible. I use dental floss for this and it works very well but you can use crochet thread or any yarn that will pull through easily.

Every 5 or 10 rows (or at the beginning of a pattern repeat, it's up to you), use a yarn needle to thread the dental floss through each stitch on the needles. Then continue to knit as usual. After another number of rows, if all is well, you can remove the floss and reinsert it the same way. But if you have a mistake you can safely unravel your work back to the life-line without dropping any stitches and pick up your work from that point.
